

Weatherly in First

The Weatherly, owned by Doug Jones, 1422 First St., was the overall Class A winner in the 36th annual 100-miler race, held in stormy weather Saturday on Green bay. Jones' boat finished with a corrected time of five hours 18 minutes, 25 seconds.

Europa of Chicago, Ill., took second place in Class A, with

a corrected time of five hours, 30 minutes, 12 seconds, while Endurance, owned by Roger Derusha of 314 First St., captured third place with corrected time of five hours, 30 minutes 39 seconds. The Sassy, of Grosse Pointe, Mich., which crossed the finish line first in both the Chicago to Mackinac and Port Huron to Mackinac

races, finished fourth in Class A with a corrected time of five hours and 32 minutes.

Charmer III, of Milwaukee, was fifth with corrected time of five hours, 36 minutes and 28 seconds. Barabaree, of Chicago, Ill., placed sixth with corrected time of five hours, 37 minutes and 24 seconds. Onalee III of Chicago, finished seventh with a time of five hours, 37 minutes, 38 seconds, followed by the Norwester, of Sturgeon Bay, taking eighth, with a time of five hours, 40 minutes, 15 seconds. Ninth was the Firebrand, of Chicago, with five hours, 44 minutes, 10 seconds corrected time, and the Rogue, of Milwaukee, placed 10th with a corrected time of five hours, 46 minutes, five seconds.

In Class B, Magic, of Milwaukee, was first with time of five hours, 33 minutes, 52 seconds, followed by Omega, of Milwaukee, with time of five hours, 38 minutes, 36 seconds with five hours, 45 minutes, 25 seconds. Wild Irish, of Chicago, finished fourth with a corrected time of five hours, 47 minutes, six seconds, and Thunder, of Green Bay, placed fifth with corrected time of five hours, 47 minutes, 57

50 minutes, 30 seconds and Bette Joy, of Gladstone, with corrected time of eight hours, 34 minutes, 26 seconds.

In the Universal Class boats, Inferno, of Marinette, finished in first place with a corrected time of eight hours, 52 minutes, 36 seconds, followed by Yama, owned by John Wormwood of 605-14th Ave., eight hours, 16 minutes, 57 seconds; and My Son, of Menominee, sailed by Russell Bradley, 1103-First St., eight hours, 52 minutes, 36 seconds, in fourth place was Debutante, of Menominee, followed by Arete, of Escanaba, with a time of nine hours, 49 minutes, 21 seconds, and Calarina, owned by Harold Derusha, of Marinette, with a time of 10 hours, seven minutes, 35 seconds.
